1. Speak with Academic Advisor in School of Allied Health & Nursing (AHN) located in Genecov Building-**G-222**.
2. Complete prerequisite coursework or provide estimated date of completion (if currently enrolled). Course grade of "C" or higher must be obtained in ALL prerequisite courses to be considered for admission into the respiratory care program.

3. Complete Allied Health and Nursing Admission Application.
4. Gather copies of ALL previous college transcripts (if completed other than Tyler Junior College). These do not have to be official copies. Items will be used to rank applicants according to point system detailed in application packet (pg. 8).
Application deadline is JUNE 1st of EACH year. Candidates completing pre-respiratory care courses during the summer may submit an application for consideration of admission provided you submit proof of enrollment in these courses along with the application.
