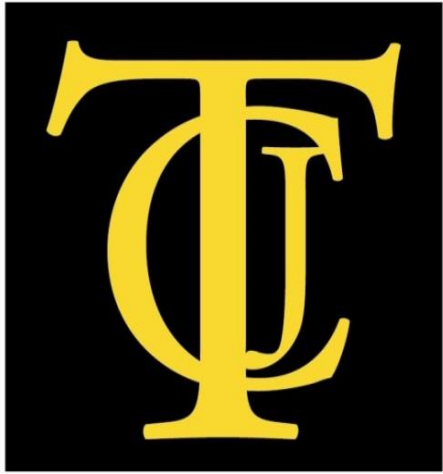

**CAMPUS ORGANIZATIONS
INFORMATION PACKET**

ELECTIONS:

1. All recognized organizations may have a Homecoming King and/or Queen nominee.
2. Homecoming nominees are open to both freshmen and sophomores.
3. All nominees' paperwork is due Friday, October 4th, 2013 by NOON to the Center for Student Life and Involvement. The entry fee is \$30 per couple or \$15 per person to cover the cost of the corsage, boutonniere and sashes.
4. All homecoming nominees must attend a **MANDATORY** campaign meeting on Tuesday, October 8th at 5:00 PM following the Student Senate meeting in Jenkins 1109.
5. All homecoming nominees' must have their headshot taken during the scheduled dates at Creative Services office or provide a digital headshot.
6. Homecoming nominees **MUST** be full-time students (enrolled in 12 hours or more) and in good standing academically (overall 2.0 GPA).
7. Voting will take place on Monday, October 21st - Wednesday, October 23rd from 9 AM – 4 PM at the Information Desk in Rogers Student Center & Jenkins Hall.
8. The Top 5 Homecoming Kings and Queens will be announced on Friday, October 25 at the Pep Rally.
9. The "Most Beautiful" girl and "Most Handsome" guy will be chosen from overall Homecoming court nominees on Thursday evening at Campus Capers and will be presented at the football game before the announcement of our Top 5 Homecoming King and Queen nominees.
10. Twenty-five points will be awarded to each organization for each homecoming nominee. Fifty points will be awarded to the organization for each nominee that was chosen to be in the Top 5.

COMPETITIONS:

A. Office Decorating

- Any recognized organization may decorate a designated office, department or residence hall and receive a \$25.00 reimbursement help cover cost of decorations.
- Each organization must sign up in the Center for Student Life and Involvement Office by Friday, October 11th by NOON to enter and return all receipts to the CSLI office on Friday, October 18th by NOON.
- Judging will take place on Tuesday, October 22nd.
- Thirty points will be given toward the "Warrior Spirit Award" to those who participate in the Best Office Building competition. First Place winners will receive an additional sixty points, second place will receive fifty points and third place will receive forty points.

B. Sidewalk Chalk

- Any recognized organization may decorate a designated portion of sidewalk on Monday, October 21st.
- Sidewalk Chalk will be provided to the organization. Addition colors will not be provided and, if desired, organization must cover extra cost.
- Each organization must sign up by Friday, October 11th by NOON.
- Judging will take place on Tuesday, October 22nd.
- Thirty points will be given toward the "Warrior Spirit Award" to those who participate in the Sidewalk Chalk competition. First Place winners will receive an additional sixty points, second place will receive fifty points and third place will receive forty points.

C. Float

- Any recognized organization may decorate a float to transport and present its Homecoming Nominees in the Apache Nation Parade and receive a \$25.00 reimbursement to help cover the cost of supplies.
- Each organization must sign up in the Center for Student Life and Involvement Office by Friday, October 11th by NOON to enter and return all receipts to the CSLI office on Friday, October 18th by NOON.
- No motorized vehicles will be allowed and floats must be operated manually by either pushing or pulling the float.
- Judging will take place at 10 AM on Friday, October 25th, prior to the Apache Nation Parade.
- Thirty points will be given toward the “Warrior Spirit Award” to those who participate in the Float competition. First Place winners will receive sixty points, second place will receive fifty points and third place will receive forty points.

D. Campus Capers

- Any recognized organizations may enter an act for Campus Capers. Tryouts for Campus Capers are at 6 PM on October 8th and 9th in the Rogers Student Center Apache Rooms. Rehearsals will take place at 6 PM on Tuesday, October 22nd in Wise Auditorium.
- There will be a tryout fee of \$25.00 for up to 3 people and \$10 each for each additional member (\$55 maximum). An information sheet must be submitted prior to trying out.
- Groups must perform the same routine or song at Campus Capers as they performed at tryouts, if selected. Groups MUST present a roster at rehearsal and every member of the group must be a registered TJC student (NO SUBSTITUTION). Groups are judged by members of/selected by the Center for Student Life and Involvement and ten groups will be selected to perform at the show. Music and lyrics must have NO offensive language and MUST meet TJC Civility Standards.
- The ten chosen acts will perform at **Campus Capers in Wise Auditorium at 7:30 PM on Thursday, October 24th. All performers must be there when doors open at 7 PM!**
- Prizes will be awarded as follows: \$300 for first place, \$200 for second place, \$100 for third place.
- Any organization that participates in tryouts will be given ten points and twenty-five points will be given to the ten organizations that are chosen to perform at Campus Capers toward the “Warrior Spirit Award”.

E. Drum Beat

- Drum Beat started in 1948 and it is an unbroken tradition since that time. The drum beats to the Apache Cadence 24 hours a day starting on Monday of Homecoming Week at 8 AM and continuing until kickoff at the game on Saturday. The tradition of the drumbeat is that if it does not stop we will win the game on Saturday but if it stops we will lose the game. Tradition has held for the past 19 years, with one exception, one time the drumbeat stopped and we tied the game. But it was the worst weather that you can imagine for a football game. It hailed, rained one inch per thirty minutes, and had cloud to ground lightning, with the game being delayed three times due to the lightning.
- Ten Points will be given per hour toward the “Warrior Spirit Award” to the organization beating the drum.

Failure to turn in any receipt on Friday, October 18th by NOON can/will result in disqualification from the competition!
