Pamela Wilson

Pam Wilson is a 38-year veteran who is retired. She is a past President of Texas Educational Theatre Association for which she served on the Board of Directors for 18 years as secretary before assuming the role of President. Pam is a recipient of the Texas Thespian Hall of Fame, a UIL Excellence Award and TETA's Emeritus Award. She is CEDFA member and has conducted many workshop for educators as well as students in Texas. She currently serves TETA as the Treasurer.

Jerry D. Cotton

Jerry has been a UIL AOP judge since 1987, and he has judged over 180 contests. He holds a Ph.D. in Theatre from Texas Tech, where George Sorensen served as his major professor. Dr. Cotton has worked as an actor onstage in educational, community and professional theatre, and in film and television with major roles in Walker Texas Ranger, Dallas, American Outlaws, and Friday Night Lights. He has extensive experience as a theatre director, set and lighting designer, playwright and screenwriter. In 2012, he retired after 38 years of teaching theatre at the college and university level. He loves judging OAP contests and doing clinics, and he has served as an adjudicator at all levels from Zone to State.

Candice Koern

After nearly 30 years as a high school theatre educator, Koern is happily retired! She has appeared at State UIL as an actor and as a director for both OAP and Theatrical Design. In college, Koern received an Irene Ryan nomination and was named outstanding Student Teacher of the Year. In 2019, she was awarded the KHOU Great Day Houston Red Apple Teacher Award. In addition, Koern was the resident director of the Bridgeland Community Theatre in Cypress, having produced and directed theatrical productions, workshops and drama camps for area residents. Koern has served on the TXETA Playfest Committee and the UT-Austin Educator's Forum.
