APACHE RECREATION CENTER

The ARC offers outdoor disc golf and basketball, indoor weight and exercise training, intramural sports and other recreational activities on wooded acreage at the northeast corner of the TJC Central Campus. TJC.edu/ARC

COUNSELING SERVICES

The primary objective of TJC Counseling Services is to help students with personal, emotional and adjustment problems so that they can succeed in college. Six free sessions per long semester permitted. TJC.edu/Counseling

DENTAL HYGIENE CLINIC

Services provided by dental hygiene students under the supervision of registered dental hygienists and general dentists. Free for TJC students and reduced cost for the public. TJC.edu/DentalClinic

DISABILITY SERVICES

PATHWAY TO COMFORT PANTRY

PERKINS CTE SUCCESS CENTER

The Carl D. Perkins Grant Program at TJC is a federally-funded program that provides community colleges with resources to develop and maintain programs in Career and Technical Education as well as provide financial assistance to students enrolled in these areas of study. TJC.edu/Perkins

TJC NOW

The TJC NOW emergency grant was established to fund the immediate needs of students at TJC. Funds can help with books/supplies, groceries, housing, transportation (fuel), medical and technology. TJC.edu/NOW

UTH-TJC HEALTH CLINIC

The campus clinic can test for flu, strep, UTI and check blood glucose levels.

The clinic can complete required physicals for athletes and students entering nursing or other allied health programs. Flu shots are free for current TJC students. No appointment necessary.

Attendance is mandatory to receive credit	Attendance is a choice, but strongly needed to pass		





APACHE ACCESS



If you know the Course Reference Number (CRN) for your classes, you may enter the CRN for each class in the Add Class section and click on Submit Changes to register for your classes.



If you do not know the CRN for your classes, you will need to select Class Search.



Scroll to find your Subject, highlight your selection and click on Course Search.



Scroll down to find the specific class number and click on View Sections.



If you use the Worksheet, you must click Submit Changes to successfully register your classes.

Check the box in front of the CRN. You may select Register or Add to Worksheet. Repeat the Class Search to continue adding other classes.



Note: You will not be able to register until all holds are cleared



CAMPUS POLICE AND PARKING

CAMPUS POLICE

Campus Police provide valuable security to everyone on campus at TJC. Our officers seek to create a safe and secure environment in which the educational mission of the College can be realized free from the threat of crime. The Campus Police department offers a variety of services such as vehicle boosts and unlocks. They also offer a safe walk service to any student, day or night.

STUDENT ID

After your bill is settled, students may get their picture taken for their ID at any time at the Campus Police station.

PARKING

To park at TJC, students are required to have a parking permit. These are available through TJC Campus Police beginning Aug. 1 to all registered students.

TJC ALERTS

Students are automatically enrolled in TJC Alerts for notifications regarding emergency situations. Students can receive alerts via text message, email, and/or phone call. Up to three phone numbers, three email addresses, and three voice-only telephone numbers can be provided in the TJC Alerts section of Apache Access.

RAVE GUARDIAN APP

Help and resources are just one click away through the RAVE Guardian app available for download through your app store. Virtual safety timers, discreet contact to Campus Police, push notifications and much more are utilized to ensure the safety of TJC students.

ADDITIONAL SAFETY MEASURES

You will find multiple safety systems throughout campus, including well-lit areas, video surveillance, and numerous blue safety poles that allow people to directly contact the police department in case of emergency.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

FERPA

FERPA (Family Education Rights and Privacy Act) governs the disclosure of – and access to – education records maintained by an educational institution.

Once a student of any age enters college, the student owns their education record; and parents may only access it if the student chooses to provide written permission.

The student can complete the form online under the eForms tab in Apache Access, or they may fill out the form in person in the Apache Enrollment Center, located on the first floor of White Administrative Services Center.

The form covers two areas: 1) academic, and 2) business and financial services. The student may choose to disclose some, all or none of this information. If completing this form in person, students should bring a legal form of ID such as a driver's license.


Central Campus Map - Eastern Front


