Tyler Junior College received funds for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA).

Tyler Junior College received \$3,697,824 for student awards and intends to disburse \$3,697,824 directly to students. As of 05/31/21, TJC has distributed the full student allocation of \$3,697,824.00 plus funds transferred from institutional designated funds. TJC has distributed a total of \$6,847,500.00 in TJC COVID Relief Grant funds to 4,565 students.

Tyler Junior College Policy in awarding TJC COVID Relief Grants

Awards will be made automatically to students enrolled in Spring, 2021, in the following priority order:

All Pell eligible* students will receive a \$1,500 award.

*Pell eligible is defined as any student having an EFC within the Pell EFC range for the specific aid year as defined by the Department of Education whether or not they actually were paid the Pell grant.

Or

Any TJC Now approved* applicant

TJC NOW approved applicants will receive a \$1500 award as follows:

The NOW applicants must have been determined to have an exceptional financial need relating to tuition, food, housing, healthcare, child care, transportation or any other cost of attendance related emergency expense due to the coronavirus.

Continued Automatic Awarding:

If funds remain:

All students with an EFC range of 4,401-10,000 will receive a \$1,500 award (prioritized by EFC code lowest to highest)

If there are remaining funds once all eligible Spring, 2021, students are awarded, awards will be made to enrolled students for Summer, 2021, and Fall, 2021, with the same priority classes listed above.

Students eligible to receive awards made automatically will receive the funding and no action is needed. All other students must fill out the TJC NOW application to be considered for an award. Each awarded student will receive an email informing them the award was made.
