*What can you do?*

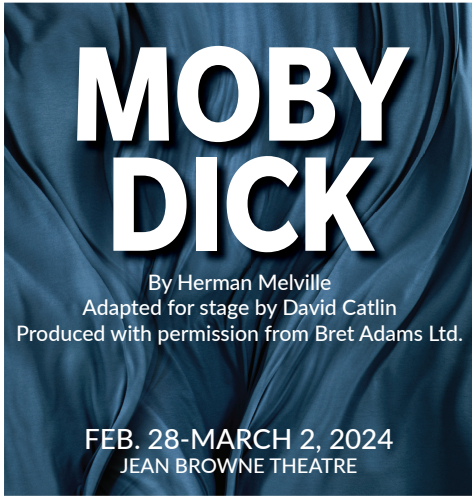
Laugh, cry and applaud at the appropriate places. Respect the performers and fellow audience members. You'll have a more enjoyable theatre experience!
