5 STEPS TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

01 APPLY. We want your admission process to go as smoothly as possible. To apply, go to www.tjc.edu/apply. If you're already a student, skip to the next step.

CLEAR HOLDS. If you have a hold on your account, you have to clear the hold before you can register for classes. View your holds in your Apache Access account.

03 LOG IN TO APACHE ACCESS. On the Home tab, on the left-hand side in the "Quick Links" channel, click the "Register Here" button.

FIND YOUR CLASSES. Select the term for which you would like to register. Enter the CRN number for the class, or search for the class by subject. When you find a class you would like to register for, click the check mark box to the left and click the "Register" button.

05 PAY YOUR TUITION. Pay either online on your Apache Access account, online on your parents' account, or at the cashiers office. Final registration for Spring will be Friday, Jan. 10, from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. and payment must be made at that time.
