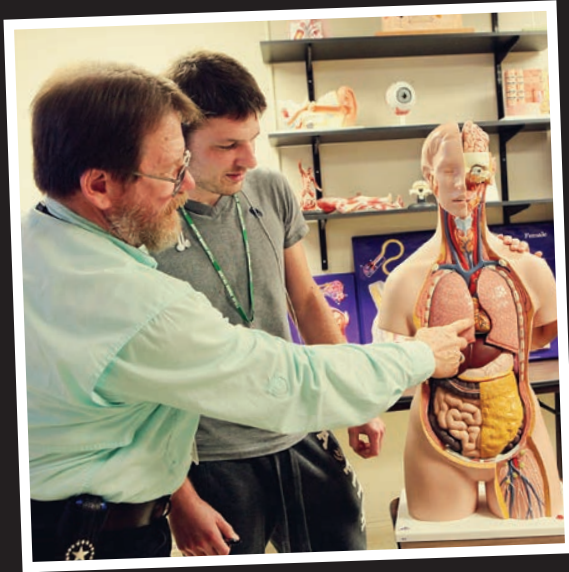

TJC also offers intramural sports, club sports, and a health and physical education center open to all students.

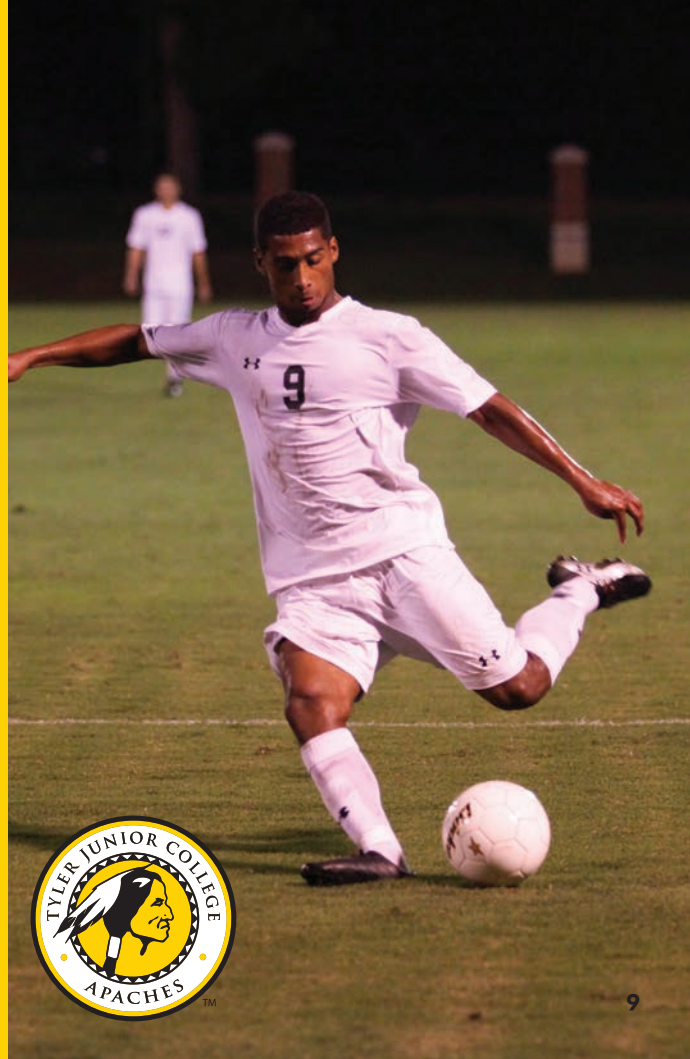

## Commit to Complete

Tyler Junior College is committed to assisting students in their efforts to achieve their educational goals. Two-thirds of all new jobs that produce livable wages require a credential beyond high school. Students who complete a certificate or degree are far more likely to be hired and far less likely to become unemployed. Furthermore, research indicates that upon transfer into a baccalaureate program, students who complete an associate degree are more likely to complete a bachelor's degree than are students who transfer without completing a degree. Each year, TJC students are asked to commit or renew their commitment to completing a degree or certificate at Tyler Junior College. Likewise, faculty and staff commit themselves to assisting students however possible as they strive to keep that commitment.
