



Carl D. Perkins Grant Guidelines

2021-2022

******Please note: If your income is too high for a Federal Pell grant (FAFSA),
then you are not eligible for the Perkins Grant**

All Perkins participants must be full-time students majoring in an Associate of Applied Sciences degree, certificate, or health science program as listed in the Tyler Junior College course catalog. Schedules will be verified that at least half of the classes registered goes towards declared major. Awards are based on the amount of the Perkins V: Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act funding available each semester. Your current major must be listed correctly in the Registrar's office.

All Perkins applicants must:

- **Must have turned in admissions application to admissions office.**
- **Apply for the FAFSA Federal Pell Grant online or through the TJC financial aid office.**
- **Must be eligible for AND receiving Pell Grant funding.**
- **Turn in the Perkins Grant application and all documentation, by the appropriate deadline.**
- **Sign all Perkins Grant contracts prior to funds being dispersed.**
- **Maintain a 2.0 GPA and maintain full-time (12 hour) status without excessive absences.**
- **Progress should be evident toward a major to qualify for future funding.**
- **Meet with the Darlene Cole, CTE Success Specialist, BEFORE dropping any courses.**

If you are awarded the Perkins Grant, you must maintain your eligibility throughout the semester. If at any time you drop below fulltime status (12 hours) or your GPA drops below a 2.0 then your Perkins funding will cease immediately and you will be required to return any items that were purchased for you using Perkins funds. Perkins must pay directly to the chosen daycares, tool suppliers and on campus bookstore for textbooks. Students are not reimbursed for purchases.

DEPENDENT CARE is limited to three dependents per family. It is paid directly to the designated licensed care facility or registered family home at a weekly rate based on the age of the child(ren). Children 12 and up are not eligible. Childcare funding from other sources such as CCS must be reported. Childcare funding cannot be awarded from another source and Perkins at the same time. Excessive absences of a child from daycare will result in cancellation of funds. Payment is made at the beginning of each month. The rates are as follows and are subject to change.

Infants to age 1-----	\$65.00
Ages 1 to 2-----	\$60.00
Ages 2 and up to Kindergarten-----	\$50.00
After school care-----	\$40.00

TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT is available to those Perkins participants who drive 20 or more miles to attend class on campus. Transportation reimbursement is based on a round trip calculation from verified home address to campus that classes are located. Verification is done through MapQuest. Attending Clinicals cannot be counted in your mileage. Mileage is reimbursed at \$0.10 per mile. Mileage log sheets must be picked up at the beginning of the month, filled in, and returned to the Perkins office by the last business day of the month. Failure to turn in log sheet by the last business day of the month will forfeit payment for that month. Participants will be notified when checks are ready to be picked up in the Perkins Office. Please record exact trip mileage as stated on signed contract. Rate is subject to change.

BOOK LOANS are available to students who qualify. Books can only be vouchered from the on-campus bookstore. Books must be returned to the Perkins office by the due date at the end of each semester. Failure to do so will result in a "hold" being placed on records. This will prevent future enrollment, transfer, and/or release of transcripts. Students who are currently enrolled in a Health Science Program have the option of keeping their books at the end of the semester. Perkins students may write/highlight in the books. If the books are lost or destroyed, the student will be responsible for the replacement cost of the items. All previously used textbooks that are replaced with updated versions will be available to CTE students for free in our office.

TOOLS are available to Perkins participants who are enrolled in Automotive Technology, HVAC/Refrigeration, Electrical/Electronic Controls, Culinary, or Welding Technology programs. Uniforms, clothing, and consumables are not allowable purchases. Student must be registered in program classes in order to be considered for assistance. Tools are purchased through the Perkins office from the official tool list of the program you are enrolled in. \$500 per semester is available for tools. This rate is subject to change.
